When the available plots are taken entries will close and all those who cannot be accommodated will be immediately informed by telephone and their entry payment returned. All Chertsey Agricultural Association Perpetual Shields and Cups will be awarded as appropriate. Prize money and commemorative prize cards will be given as detailed.
