#### **PEDIGREE PIG CLASSES**

**Open to any pig registered with the British Pig Association or British Lop Pig Society**

**Class 1P – Boar born between 1<sup>st</sup> July 2018 and 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018**

**Class 2P – Boar born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019**

**Class 3P – Breeding sow born before 1<sup>st</sup> July 2018**

**Class 4P – Gilt born between 1<sup>st</sup> July 2018 and 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018**

**Class 5P – Gilt born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019**

**(Classes may be added if there are more than 6 entries of any single breed in any class)**

**OTHER AWARDS/BREED SOCIETY ROSETTES TBA****GENERAL RULES**

1. Please adhere to all DEFRA Rules and Regulations, including necessary movement documents and identifications.
2. Movement to and from exhibition or show
  - a. All pigs coming to the show must be accompanied by eAML2 forms for both the inbound and outbound journeys.
  - b. In accordance with the rules a copy of the inbound form will be retained on the showground for inclusion in the show herd register.
  - c. If you are thinking of selling a pig at the show you should bring a blank Show Sale Haulier Form (available online from the eAML2 bureau) with you to the show. If a sale occurs, this should then be completed in accordance with the rules and handed to the purchaser.
  - d. All pigs coming to the show should be identified in accordance with the rules. The identification should include your herd mark and a unique identification number for each animal.
3. Pigs to slaughter
  - a. Exhibitors/stockmen will be responsible for slap marking the pigs.
  - b. Exhibitors/stockmen are responsible for transporting their animals to the abattoir.
  - c. Animals going to slaughter will need to be accompanied by a Show Sale Haulier Form (available online from the eAML2 bureau) and Food Chain Information. These should be completed in accordance with the rules and handed to the abattoir.
4. To conform to pig health schemes please ensure that all animals are free of lice.
5. Colouring – The use of artificial colouring, whitening and/or powder on pigs, as well as the removal or addition of spots by artificial means is prohibited. (White woodflour is permitted).
6. Exhibitors/stockmen will be responsible for exhibiting their pigs in the ring.
7. Exhibitors/stockmen must be dressed appropriately when in the ring and this is to include a white coat.
8. Exhibitors/stockmen must use a board and bat/stick when showing in the ring.
9. Exhibitors/stockmen must use a board when moving animals at any time.
10. Exhibitors/stockmen who are exhibiting stock in the ring must have the sufficient strength and ability to control the animal they are accompanying.

**ADDITIONAL RULES FOR CLASSES 1P - 5P**

1. Pigs to have been registered in a published volume or accepted for entry in a forthcoming volume of the British Pig Association's Herd Book (It is not sufficient for an animal to be "eligible for registration"). Animals registered in a Grading Register of a Herd Book are not eligible for entry in Agricultural Show Classes. The ear number, registered name, Herd Book number and date of birth of each pig must be supplied for printing in the catalogue together with the name of the breeder in cases where the exhibitor is not also the breeder.
2. Female pigs (all breeds) born before 1st January 2018 shall be eligible to compete only if in the six calendar months prior to the Show they have farrowed, suckled and reared to four weeks of age, a litter of pigs.
3. All female pigs born on or after 1st January 2018 and before 1<sup>st</sup> July 2018 must within 18 months of their date of birth have farrowed, suckled and reared to four weeks of age, a litter of pigs.
4. **All boars must be shown by two competent adult handlers who are equipped with protective boards.**
5. Boars aged twelve months or more at the time of exhibition must have their tusks cut prior to the show.
