

Rules and conditions of entry.

1. All equines must be 4 years or over.
2. All horses/ponies on the showground must be covered by third party insurance. Checks may be made and documents must be produced.
3. Any excess use of whips, or failure to obey an order by a judge or steward in or out of the ring may result in disqualification from the show & loss of entries.
4. No claim can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants or animals in connection with or arising out of the show. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from such accidents.
5. All competitors must be in the ring when required or may face disqualification.
6. All entries must be in writing on the entry form together with the appropriate fees.
7. Entries close 28th July.
8. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times and mess cleaned up please.
9. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without explanation.
10. The Judges decision is final. Only officially presented objections will be considered (as described in rule 11)
11. Objections, which will be heard by members of the Executive Committee present on the ground, must be made in writing to the Secretary and accompanied by £50, within 30 minutes of the incident giving rise to the objection. The deposit will be forfeited unless the objection is upheld or the committee considers that there were reasonable grounds for it to be made. Only the owner, his authorised agent or the competitor is entitled to lodge an objection.
12. Entry fees will only be fully refunded on the production of a Veterinary or Doctors certificate at least 24 hours prior to the beginning of the show. Later requests for a refund will be at the discretion of the Driving Secretary and will be a percentage of the entry fee.
13. Anyone under the age of 14 years on the day of the show, either whip, groom or passenger MUST wear a correctly fitted hard hat whilst in a carriage or in attendance to a turnout.
14. The Committee reserves the right to vary the composition of the schedule according to circumstances or to cancel or amalgamate any class in which there are less than 6 entries.

Type – Sections:

a – Single hackney-type – over 13.2hh

b – Single hackney-type – 13.2hh & under

g - Single purebred Registered Welsh Ponies – Sections A, B & C.

j – Two wheeled Light Trade

k – Four wheeled Light Trade

l – Single or Tandem Turnout driven to a two-wheel exercise vehicle

m - Single, Pair or Tandem Turnout driven to a 4 wheeled exercise vehicle.

The Champion will qualify for the Grand Final to be held on Sunday 15th

Manor, Crick, Chepstow, Monmouth, NP26 5XP. In the event the Cham-

pion has already qualified then the Reserve Champion to qualify. If the

Reserve has also qualified, the rosette be awarded back to the Champion.

Once qualified, horse, whip and vehicle must not be changed.

A green coloured lorry parking pass for the car-

riage driving area on the far side of the field will

be issued.

3 wrist bands will be issued for each carriage

driving horse entered, maximum of 6 bands.

You must have these on your wrist to gain access

to the show ground.

Anyone wishing to enter the showground must

wear a wristband, these can be purchased at

time of entry or on the main pedestrian gate on

the day.

Failure to wear a band will result in denied ac-

cess to the showground.

Please warm up at the far end of the parking

area away from the lorry park and be respectful

to all other competitors.

To be split if sufficient entries, to also include best novice. A novice horse/pony is defined as an animal not to have won a first in harness in a previous season. Please state novice eligibility on entry form.
Driven to traditional or traditional type vehicles, singles & multiples. Horses and ponies to be 4 years and over. No hackney wagons or trade vehicles permitted.

3.15 Class 8

Open to ponies registered in either the Connemara, Dale, Dartmoor, Eris-kay, Exmoor, Fell, New Forest, Highland, Shetland or Welsh stud books.
Numbers must be given on the entry form.
Open to traditional & non-traditional type vehicles or an exercise vehicle fitted with traditional wheels.

Special rosette to highest placed non-welsh.

All horses/ponies must be registered in the studbook of the UK Hackney Horse Society or of a recognized Hackney Society abroad and all exhibitors, drivers, groomers must be members of the Hackney Horse Society. Minimum age of driver in open and novice class will be 14 years at date of the show.
Horses or ponies eligible for a novice class can only be shown for 3 seasons (non – consecutive).

Open to **ANY** driven turnout or long reined equine wanting advice or help to progress in a driving discipline. The gentlemen will observe and advise to help you progress. Take advantage of this opportunity from the experts! Driven horses and ponies to be 4yrs and over, long reined youngsters permitted but must be under control at all times.

PLEASURE DRIVING CLASS - Driving ring

9.45 Class 2

Pleasure driving classes are for newcomers to showing and not intended for those who show in Private riving Classes. Regular showing competitors are asked to respect this. Pneumatic tyres specifically designed for carriages are permitted, lamps need not be carried. To be judged:

15% vehicle suitability, fit and cleanliness; 15% harness suitability, fit and cleanliness; 70% driver & groom, horse/pony, way of going and suitability as a family pleasure animal. Competitors may be given specific movements to execute their show. Open to horses, ponies, donkeys & mules. A single or a pair capable of seating 2 or more persons. Open to traditional / traditional – type or exercise vehicles and for the purpose of the class will be judged on equal merit. Horses and ponies to be 4 years and over.

NOVICE WHIP Driving Ring

10.15 Class 3

Whip not to have won a first prize in a driving class at any BDS affiliated show before 1st January 2019. Open to any vehicle. Should a Novice Whip be a junior they must be accompanied in the vehicle by a competent adult whip. Special prize & rosette the best junior. Horses and ponies to be 4 years and over.

LIGHT TRADE – MAIN RING

11.00 Class 4

Horses/ponies 4 years and over. To be shown in traditional trade harness, no goods to be carried, unless a coster turnout when a small sample load may be carried. Empty containers (e.g. milk churns) are permitted. Will be spilt into 2 and 4 wheeled if 4 or more entries in each section. The best 2 turnouts of each section will qualify for the championship in either case.

WELSH PONY / COB TO WAGON – MAIN RING

1.00 Class 5

Single registered Welsh Section A,B,C,D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years and over. Exhibits to be shown to a wagon with traditional black harness. A whip may not be carried but must be on the vehicle. Class will be split into ponies A, B, C & section D.

1st & 2nd in each section to go forward to the championship.

EXERCISE VEHICLE DRIVING - Driving Ring

2.00 Class 6

Class to include Best Novice Animal and Best Novice Whip, need not be the same turnout.

Novice whip and equines not to have won a first prize in a previous season.

Statement of eligibility to be stated on entry form.

For non-traditional and exercise vehicles. Two or four wheeled vehicles put to either a single, pair or tandem. Horses/ponies any height, 4 years and over. Please note this is a show class and the standards of the BDS show classes are to be respected. Judged on cleanliness, safety, correct fitting of harness and driving ability.
