Classification

Beginners:

For 'first timers' and anyone eligible to compete in Kennel Club shows at Grade 1 or 2.

Any dog that has not previously qualified out of Grade 2 at a KC show is eligible for this class.

(An advanced/novice handler, or owner, must start a NEW dog at Grade 2 this year, as long as the dog has not previously been entered at grade 3 at a KC show.)

If you win into Grade 3 before the 16th July 2019 please let me know & I'll promote you to novice.

Novice:

KC Grades 3, 4 & 5 (Grades 6 & 7 are welcome to enter not for competition - NFC)

Maximum Height of Jumps

Toy - 250mm, Small - 350mm, Medium - 450mm, Standard - 550mm, Large - 650mm

Toy/Small/Medium will be judged as one class, jumping at their own heights.

Standard/Large will be judged as one class, jumping at their own heights.

Please see Rule 11 for details of height eligibility.

Directions

From M25:

Exit Jct 11 towards Weybridge. At next roundabout bear left towards Shepperton. Straight on at Clay Corner traffic lights (Meads School on right). Turn right at the CO-OP into Mead Lane.

From Sunbury/Shepperton: Over Chertsey Bridge and turn left at the next set of traffic lights into Weir Road. Turn left at the CO-OP into Mead Lane.

You will be directed to the agility parking as you enter the Meads.

The show is for fun – for you, your dog, and the general public, with a friendly, relaxed atmosphere. The ring is fully netted. Although it is run by me with the help of members of Paddywack Dog Training, we still need help to make the day a success, which is why helping for approximately 1 hour is a condition of entry. Information will be displayed on a notice board at the Show. **If you are not prepared to honour this commitment please do not enter.** Care will be taken to allow you plenty of time for your own dogs, and to explain to you what your job involves.

There is also a Fun Dog Show with Pedigree and Novelty classes, a timed jumping lane, a Pay On The Day Practice Ring, for any agility trained dogs, and supervised 'Have A Go' sessions for non-agility trained dogs.

As the Chertsey Show has all the usual agricultural show attractions, including livestock and machinery, dogs must be kept on lead when not competing. Beyond the showground boundaries, there is open ground down to the Thames to the north and east of the venue. If exercising in this area, please be vigilant and keep your dogs within sight. Please ensure the safety of your vehicles, property and, most importantly, your dogs at all times and operate a 'neighbourhood watch' policy.

Parking on the showground is available for competitors, but cars must enter before 9am when the show opens, & cannot leave until the show closes at 5pm, unless it is an emergency. There is parking available in the public area if you prefer.

There will be a lunch-break each day, to allow you to visit the rest of the show.

The nearby Food Court has a variety of catering stands.

There is no provision for overnight camping at the venue, except in exceptional cases.

Rules

1. Usual KC agility rules will apply unless stated otherwise. (The judge may state in their briefing if they are not marking the up contacts, & as the ring is smaller than KC regs. the spacing may not be 5m)
2. All dogs are entered at their owners' risk. Whilst every care will be taken, CAA & Paddywack Dog Training will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, dogs or property.
3. The committee/organiser reserves the right to refuse entries.
4. In the event that the show is cancelled non-recoverable expenses will be deducted before returning entry fees.
5. **All competitors must be available to help for about 1 hour per day. The show cannot run without your help.**
6. The entry fee is a minimum of £9 per day (for 3 classes). Entries may be split between more than one dog. Additional entries will be accepted at £3 per class.
7. Entries are welcomed from handlers and/or dogs who have not competed before, but all dogs must have received suitable training to participate in this event & be able to compete without causing danger to themselves or others. Any dog considered not suitably trained, or unfit to participate for any reason, will be asked to leave the ring by the judge and no refund of entry fees will be given.
8. Entries can be submitted by **email** with payment via **BACS** or **PayPal** (instructions on the entry form). By submitting the form you will be assenting to the Declaration, whether there is a signature or not.  **All information inc. the car pass, will be sent by email for you to print.** Entries will be accepted by **post**, accompanied by a cheque for fees, payable to **Chertsey Agricultural Association**. **Please include a C5 size, stamped addressed envelope if you require your entry information to be posted to you (otherwise it will be emailed for you to print).** The address to post entries/cheques is on the front page & entry form. Receipt of entry will only be made by email (if supplied).
9. Any change of grade from grade 2 to grade 3, (gained 25 days or more before the show) must be notified at least 14 days before the date of the show.
10. Dogs must be 16 months of age or over to enter the show.
11. **Jump Heights:** Dogs measuring less than 43cm (17in) at the shoulder may compete at either Toy, Small or Medium. Dogs measuring 43cm or over at the shoulder may compete at either Standard or Large, **or they can run at a lower height for Clear Round Only (CRO).**
12. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show. If this is considered to have occurred you will be asked to leave venue, no refund of entry fees will be given.
13. Competitors are permitted to bring their non-competing dogs to the show, but they must be under control.
14. Judges **may** run their own dogs on the day they are judging, but only in the classes that they are not judging and their family members **may** compete in a class that they are judging.
15. **The courses will be the same for all heights & grades, but each class will be judged separately.**
16. **Only a flat, close-fitting leather or webbing collar without any attachments (except the D-ring) can be worn. No choke chains, slip or half-slip collars, harnesses etc.**
17. **No food is allowed in the ring at any time.**
18. **Toys may be used but only if you run your dog Not for Competition (NFC). No Squeaky toys please.**
19. Anyone with dog deemed out of control will be asked to leave the venue.
20. No bitches in season allowed in the rings, or anywhere near the rings.
21. Dogs are to be kept on lead at all times in the show ground, except when running in the rings.
22. Please respect the venue and clean up after your dogs.
23. **Dog Safety.** Remedial action will be taken in the event of dogs left in vehicles being found in a distressed condition. Your dog is **vulnerable and at risk** if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. If your dog is thought to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
