

## **RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

Please report to Bio Security Officer before unloading lorry to ensure adherence to the current DEFRA Regulations.

All cattle entered must produce TB clearance certificates if applicable.

Cattle must have a valid PASSPORT and MOVEMENT CERTIFICATE on the day. No lorries to be unloaded until advised. Please make sure all wheel arches on all vehicles are disinfected before arrival on the showground.

### **Please use special Livestock entrance on the day.**

All animals must be HALTER TRAINED AND LED otherwise to remain in pen. All exhibitors must comply with MOVEMENT DOCUMENTATION to the satisfaction of Surrey Trading Standards.

All exhibitors must fill in ENTRY FORMS.

All Cattle are to be on showground by 9.00am, with judging commencing at 10.00am on Saturday and 11.00am on Sunday.

All cattle should remain until after the Grand Parade in the Main Ring on both days.

Admission is at the discretion of the Chertsey Agricultural Association.

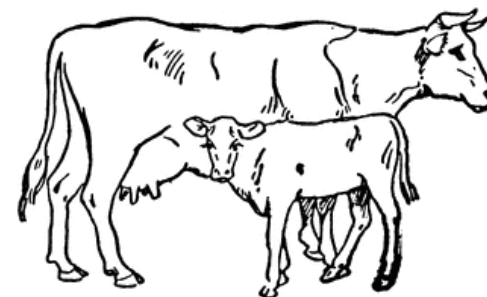

### THE DREW SMYTHE CHALLENGE CUP

will be awarded to the CHAMPION of Dexter Classes 1C-5C together with the DEXTER CATTLE CHAMPIONSHIP SPOON

### BEEF CATTLE CLASSES OF BRITISH NATIVE ORIGIN

- Class 6C BEEF COW – born before January 2017 in calf or with calf at foot
- Class 7C BEEF HEIFER born in 2017 – in calf or with calf at foot
- Class 8C BEEF HEIFER born in 2018 – yearling class

### THE ERIC RAYNER CHALLENGE C

UP awarded to the CHAMPION of Classes 6C – 8C

### CONTINENTAL BEEF CATTLE

- Class 9C BEEF COW born before January 2017 – in calf or with calf at foot
  - Class 10C BEEF HEIFER born in 2017 – in calf or with calf at foot
  - Class 11C BEEF HEIFER born in 2018 – yearling class
- THE BORTHWICK CHALLENGE CUP  
awarded to the CHAMPION in Classes 9C -11C

### BUTCHER'S BEAST

- Class 12C STEER or HEIFER – any breed or cross
- Class 13C PURE BREED BEEF BULL - must be ringed and halter led

### MR & MRS MERRYMAN'S CHALLENGE SHIELD

will be awarded to the CHAMPION of Classes 12C-13C
